

Dear Saraland Resident:

The City is pleased to provide garbage & trash services to you at a reasonable cost. Our current garbage vendor, Waste Pro, provides curbside collection carts to contain all your household garbage. The garbage is collected twice a week. Carts should be placed at the roadside by 7:00 a.m. the morning of your designated collection days, to ensure service. Carts are not to remain at the curb longer than 24 hours per City Code 44-79. When placing carts at the curb, please have the opening towards the road. Household garbage must be placed inside the cart and the cart lid must close completely to receive service. Items placed beside or on top of the garbage cart can not be picked up. Your basic service allows for one cart-full of household garbage per pickup. Additional carts may be obtained through Waste Pro for a cost of \$6.95 per month. For your convenience, Waste Pro representative, Kirsten, is located at Saraland City Hall, 727 Saraland Boulevard, S. You may also speak with her by calling (251) 277-2146. As a reminder, all Saraland residents are required to participate in this service per Alabama Code Section 22-27-3 and Saraland Code of Ordinances, Chapter 44. The only exceptions for non-participation are if the residence is under construction, if the water service has been discontinued or primary residence is greater than 750 feet from the public right-of-way (approval required).

Once a week, the City provides trash collection of up to six cubic yards of bulky waste and yard debris. Limbs may not exceed six feet in length & six inches in diameter. Leaves and pine straw must be bagged. Debris left out in excess of these specifications, are subject to a service charge for removal.

As a reminder, contractors providing services such as lawn care, tree trimming, debris removal, lot clearing, construction services, etc., are responsible for removal of debris produced by their services. The City does not pick up tires, televisions, computer monitors, or items containing glass. Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, can only be collected if items are tagged that the freon has been professionally removed.

Items left on a vacant lot, will not be picked up by the City. If you suspect someone of dumping debris or further questions concerning debris, please contact Chief McDaniel at (251) 675-5331.

If you have any additional questions or concerns, please contact my executive assistant, Christine at (251) 675-5103, and we will work together to resolve them.

The City of Saraland officials strive to provide its residents a safe, clean and inviting community. To assist in these efforts, the city will hold its Fall Clean-up Day on **Saturday, October 25, 2025**. Residents are encouraged to properly dispose of unwanted household items by participating in this event.

Acceptable Items:

- Yard Debris
- Bulky Household Items - furniture, washers, dryers, stoves, etc.
- Batteries - automobile & small engine
- Oil - motor & cooking only (**Limit 5 gallons**)
- Antifreeze
- Paint cans (**Limit 10 gallons per vehicle**)
- Tires (**Limit 6 , passenger & regular truck tires only. Rims MUST be removed**)

Unacceptable Items:

- Aerosol cans
- Hazardous or medical waste
- Mineral spirits
- Pesticides or lawn treatment chemicals
- Propane/welding tanks
- Refrigerators/freezers/air conditioners, **unless the Freon has been professionally removed and tagged**



Shred-it will be onsite for complimentary shredding of personal documents. Limit **2 banker boxes 15x10x24**

Keep Saraland Beautiful will have Ransom Recycling available to collect electronics & other various items listed below.

Computer hard drive destruction will be offered through Ransom with a limit of **4** hard drives per vehicle. If requested, a certificate of destruction will be issued and mailed once the service has been performed.

Televisions & monitors, both flat screens & tube models, will be accepted. A \$30 fee for tube models will be collected by Ransom at the event.
